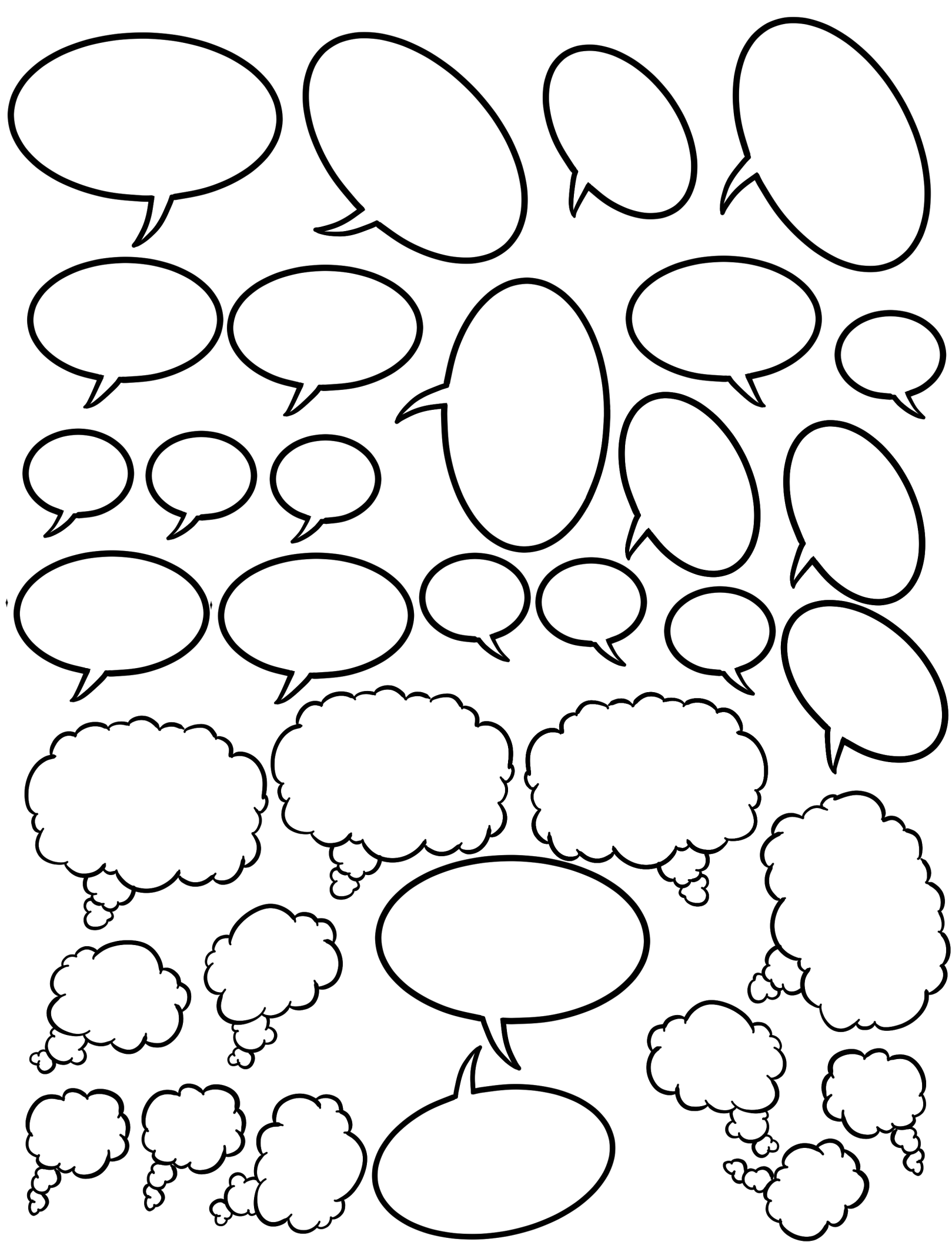


Draw and color your own background! Each square above will be the background for one panel.

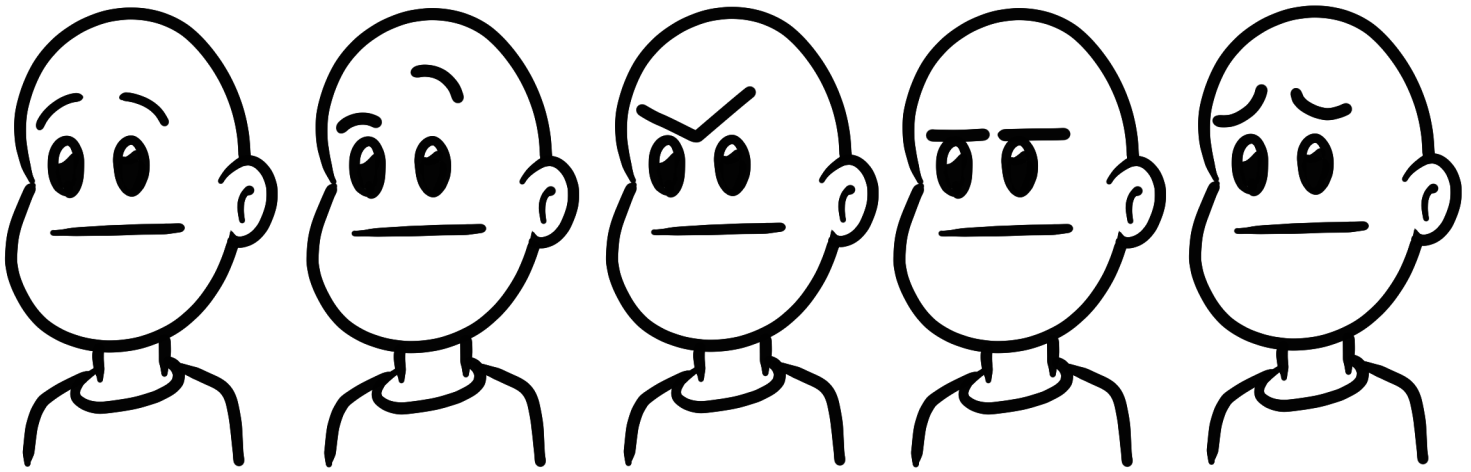


# DRAWING EXPRESSIONS

Here are a few tips to help you as you draw your character's faces!

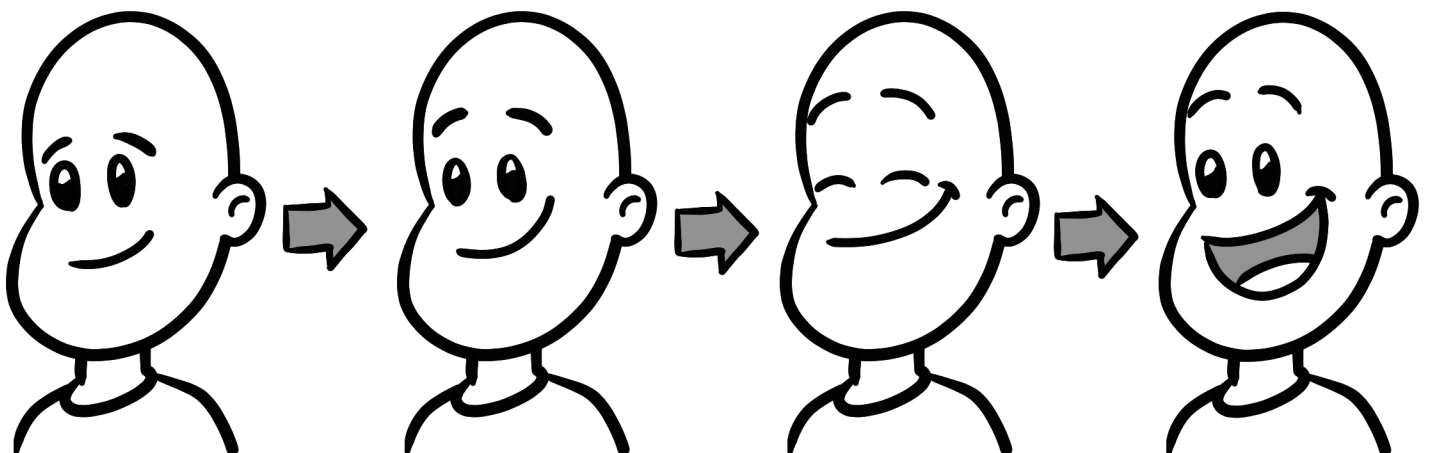
## JUST BROW-SING:

Changing a character's eyebrows can make a big change in how their expression feels! In the drawings below, the only difference is the eyebrows - how does each expression change?



## BIG FEELINGS:

Even just one feeling like happiness can look a lot of different ways! Think about *how much* the character is feeling, along with *what* they're feeling. Look how in each picture below, the character looks happier and happier!

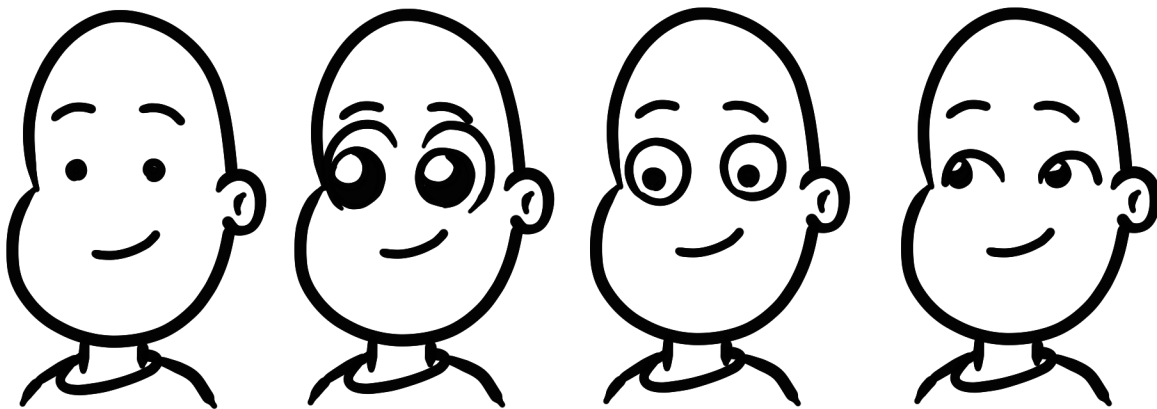


# MORE EXPRESSIONS FUN

Even more ways to have fun with your character's expressions!

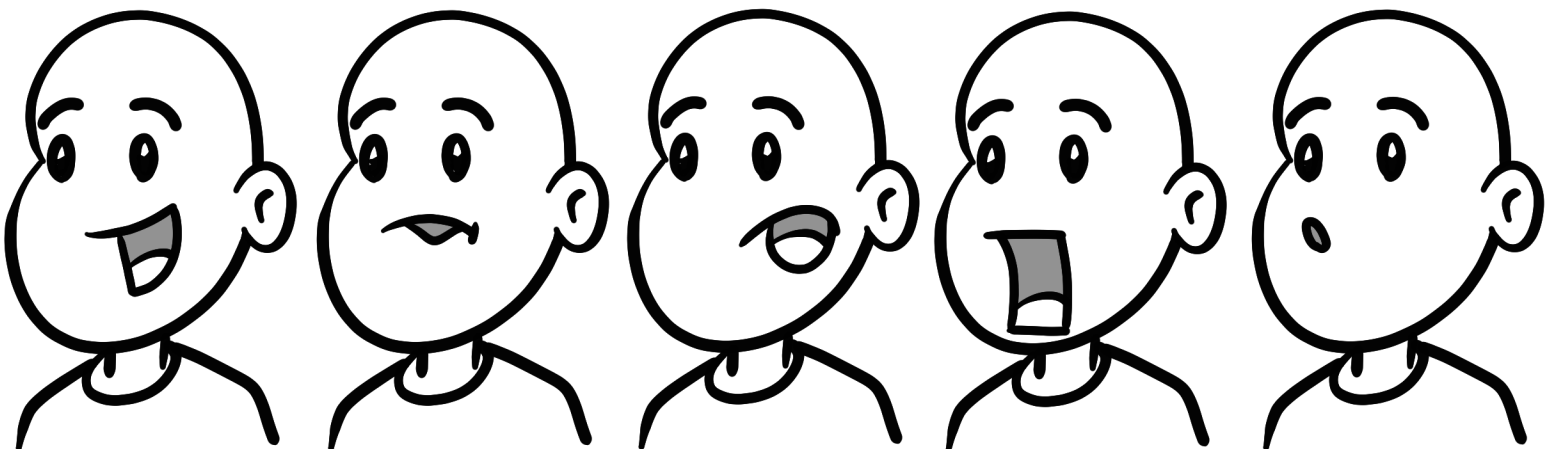
## THE EYES HAVE IT:

How you draw your character's eyes can make a big impact on their expression and how we see the character. How do each of the characters below feel different?



## SAY "AAAAAAH":

Even when a character is talking, the shape of their mouth can change, depending on how they're saying it. Play with different mouth shapes to show how your character feels about what they're saying!
